

Do-Dad/Go-Mom Patch Program

The purpose of the Do-Dad/Go-Mom patch program is to enhance adult involvement in the Calumet Council, increase support for troop and group leadership, expand program activities and retain girls and adults.

To become a Do-Dad/Go-Mom, a Girl Scout MUST have at least one adult family member or friend complete the activities listed below during the course of one registration year (beginning in September). Applications are due June 1 for the current year.

The adult who completes the requirements will receive a certificate. That adult may then go to the Service Center and purchase a patch for the Girl Scout to wear on the back of her sash/vest.

Requirements for an adult (over 21):

1. Must register as an adult Girl Scout Volunteer.
2. Must assist with an activity at the troop level, i.e. Family Partnership Chair.
3. Must assist with an activity at the service unit level, i.e. be a Service Unit Family Partnership Chair.
4. Must work at the Apple Acres Workday or Service Center Workday.
5. Must have made a donation to Family Partnership or Annual Giving of at least \$25.00.
